

# Celestial Navigation

Becket

**A1** (6) Circle left  $3/4$ , (2) Men roll Neighbor away with  $1/2$  Sashay on the side  
(8) Men Allemande left  $1\ 1/2$  While Ladies Orbit clockwise  $1/2$  way  
to cross to the other side of the set to meet her neighbor

**A2** (16) Neighbor Balance and Swing

**B1** (8) Ladies Chain

(8)  $1/2$  Hey, Ladies pass right shoulders to start

**B2** (16) Partner Balance and Swing.....slide left with Partner to meet next neighbor

**Notes :** Notes: After the men roll their neighbor lady away in A1, The man's right hand will be holding his neighbor's left hand. Ask the man to keep that connection as he takes left hands with his neighbor man in the center. Ask the men to give a little tug to his neighbor lady's hand to start her on her clockwise orbit. {Men and ladies travel in different directions as the ladies orbit - the ladies travel clockwise while the men travel counter-clockwise.} As ladies orbit, they will come face to face with another lady from the next minor set. Though it is counter-intuitive, the ladies should pass **RIGHT** shoulders with the lady she meets. {No real harm is done if she passes left shoulders, but she will arrive at her destination early.} The sequence in A1 also occurs in "Venus and Mars."
