

Hoody's Peanuts

Improper

- A1** (8) Neighbor Allemande Left $1 \frac{1}{2}$
(8) Neighbor Swing
- A2** (8) Ladies, Righth Shadow Gypsy 1X in middle to return to Neighbor
(8) Neighbor Swing
- B1** (8) Circle Left $\frac{3}{4}$
(8) Partner Swing
- B2** (8) Men Allemande Left $1 \frac{1}{2}$
(8) Neighbor Allemande Right $1 \frac{1}{2}$ to face direction of progression

Notes: You may need to help the men orient in B2. After the men allemande left $1 \frac{1}{2}$ at the top of B2, you might have the men keep left hands for a few moments to make a short wavy line across the set. Men will have left hands in the center, and all will have right hands with their Neighbor. While in this short wavy line, all will be facing opposite their direction of progression. Once you have dancers oriented, all can allemande their neighbor by the Right $1 \frac{1}{2}$ to face a new neighbor. If you have dancers make the short wavy line, emphasize that they will NOT form a wavy line in the dance; you are only using the wavy line for teaching purposes (to help them orient). That is, during the Dance, there will be no wavy line.
